  - viii. There was some money left over last year that could have been used for marketing and promotion. Lake Affect Studios wants to promote the event to local businesses and their employees.
  - ix. Rachel Oscar was on the news to promote Avenue of the Arts for Campus District. Campus District would love to do something similar for the Superior Block Party by getting Dan LaGuardia or Mark Lammon on a radio show or local news station.
